Can anyone stop her if she does try to live in Mexico?

Please keep me informed as to the proceedings and I will continue to keep up with your dialog on the web. And who knows, perhaps one day she will "see the light" and realize what she has done to so many people and their lives. And, God has his own way of making things right -- and I would not want to up against him!
