PROTOCOL TO BE OBSERVED BY STAFF AT THE HOUSE

- 1. This is Devra's residence and the need for privacy is of utmost importance.
- 2. Staff should enter and exit through the lower level of the house when reporting for work and leaving for the day.
- 3. Unnecessary conversation and socializing should not take place in the house. The kitchen is off-limits for any congregating or socializing. Work-related discussions, phone calls and staff meetings should take place on the lower level.
- 4. Keep personal phone calls to a minimum and refrain from using the house telephone number. Use 961-8585 for incoming and outgoing business calls. Cell phones should be at the lowest pitch in the house.
- 5. A code of dress should be observed. Sloppy attire is not acceptable.
- 6. Work hours are from 9 a.m. -5 p.m. for clerical workers. House manager and the assistant work from 8:30 a.m. -4:30 p.m. unless Devra requests otherwise.
- 7. The lower level kitchen facilities should be used for all food consumption.
- 8. Keep the noise level to the minimum especially at noon when Devra rests.
- 9. Please do not enter Devra's room if the door is shut. If it is absolutely necessary to go in make sure you knock first, wait for a response and then enter if she says it's OK to come in. Her room is the only place she can have some privacy.
- 10. Also, please be more aware of Devra's need for privacy during SAI and other events. We must keep the noise level down and remind others in the house too.
- 11. Make sure the lights are turned off and the heat/AC lowered or turned off before you leave for the day.
- 12. If you are not coming in to work or if you are going to be late please inform the main office of your absence or lateness.
- 13. Devra would like for the House Management staff to have aprons with their names on it and to wear khaki pants and NKS logo polo shirts.
- 14. All staff must sign the confidentiality contract. No information concerning Devra or her family should be divulged to anyone.
- 15. We should all try our very best to work together as a team thereby making Devra's life a lot easier and less stressful.
